The Trips for Kids Marin team is working tirelessly through the COVID-19 pandemic to keep our youth cycling programs relevant through virtual outreach, but we need your help.

Half of TFK Marin's revenue comes from our Re-Cyclery Bike Shop in San Rafael, which is closed to walk-in sales. With only limited online business our revenue is drastically reduced.



Over the past challenging weeks, TFK Marin's dedicated staff has developed creative ways to keep serving our students and fulfill our mission (see below), but the reality is that today our "business as unusual" is anything but usual.


TFK Marin has weathered many storms over the past three decades and we endeavor to survive this one as well. However, it will not be easy and the future is uncertain.
